- *Assisting the Skill and Event Leaders in a specific skill program by supervising students and helping out where needed*
- *Ensuring the safety and well-being of the campers and fellow staff members*
- *Assisting in any first aid situations and/or the implementation of emergency procedures as directed by NorthBay policy*
- *Communicating any issues or needs of individual campers or your team to the appropriate staff member or summer camp manager*

- *Counselor Coordinator Rachael Pitney, who will provide training and daily supervision*
- *Summer Camp Manager, Joe Antonio, who is responsible for the overall atmosphere of camp*
- *A Head Counselor who will set you up to lead and serve your campers at various events and organized activities*
